## LOGO VERSIONS: LOUISIANA CULTURAL DISTRICTS

### PRIMARY LOGO

MOST USES: Full color, light background  
Minimum size: 1.75" or 200 pixels wide

### PRIMARY LOGO - ALTERNATE

USE FOR: Full color, dark background  
Minimum size: 2" or 240 pixels wide

### SECONDARY LOGO - SPECIAL USES

USE FOR: Reproduction less than than 1.75" or 200 pixels wide  
Minimum size: 1.5" or 150 pixels wide

USE FOR: One color grayscale  
Minimum size: 1.5" or 200 pixels wide

Minimum size: 1.5" or 200 pixels wide

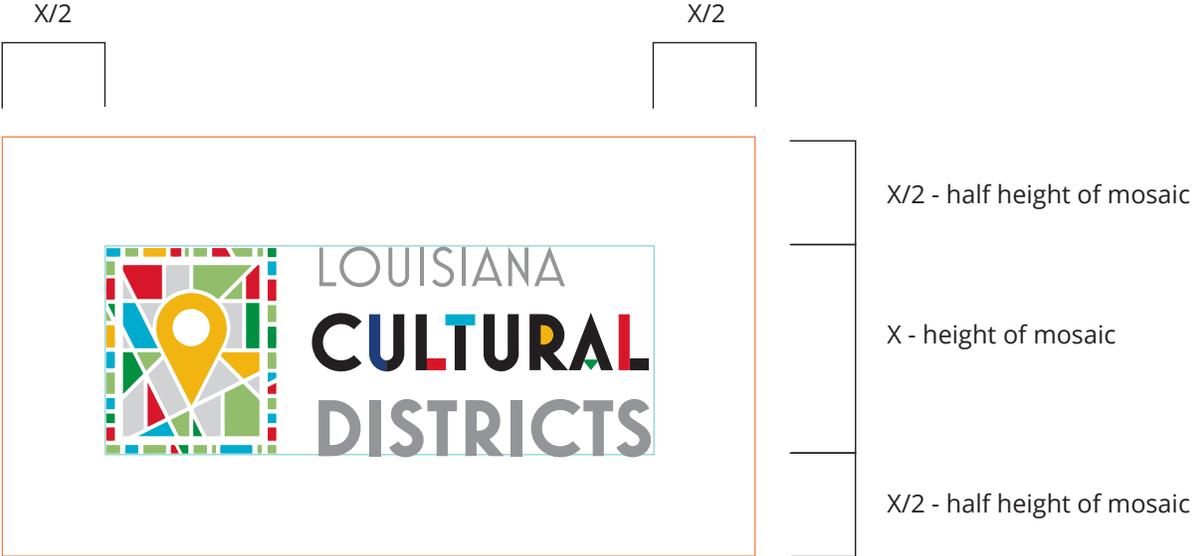
### ONE COLOR REVERSE LOGO

USE FOR: Dark color backgrounds  
Minimum size: 1.5" or 200 pixels wide  
The black background is not part of the logo

LOGO SIZE AND CLEARANCE: LOUISIANA CULTURAL DISTRICTS



**SIZE REQUIREMENTS**

Care must be given that the logo is reproduced in sizes that will be easily readable. Minimum sizes are listed with each version for usage in both print and digital media.

**MINIMUM LOGO CLEARANCE**

In usage, the logo should always have enough space around it to stand out in layouts. The guidelines above provide basic rules for minimum clearance. The clear space surrounding the logo in each version needs to be equal to or greater than one half the height of the mosaic. No other graphic should appear in this area. Wherever possible, give the logo space to “breathe” and attract the eye of the reader.
