

Panelist Selection

Each panelist will meet some but not necessarily all of the following qualifications, depending on the panel:

- 1. Professional experience as an artist or nonprofit arts administrator, in an arts-based commercial business, or in arts and cultural policy or in cultural economy development
- 2. Knowledge of standards and best practices in management, governance and operations
- 3. Knowledge in an artistic discipline or field (dance, music, theatre, visual arts and crafts, literature, media, design, folklife, arts-in-education, presenting and touring, etc.)
- 4. Awareness of discipline, industry trends and issues

A pool of panelists is recommended to the Louisiana State Arts Council during each grant cycle based on the:

- 1. Demonstration of necessary expertise proposed in grant applications for review.
- 2. Judicious demonstration of gender, diverse cultures and special populations of the state.
- 3. Representation of regional and statewide areas, although no community is guaranteed representation on a panel.

Once executive staff and the LSAC have approved potential candidates to serve on the panel, these individuals are then invited to review applications.
