Incomplete Owner Verification Forms may delay processing of your nomination. Additionally, if an individual owner notification letter, or any portion of letters going to owners within a historic district, are returned by the US Postal Service due to an incorrect address, you will be notified and your nomination may be withheld from the Review Committee agenda until proper notification can be made.
